



Dear Resident,

The Caravan Industry Australia wishes to keep you fully informed of short-term road closures during the upcoming 2012 Caravan and Camping Show. The road closures are required to ensure the safe entry of patrons into the racecourse, minimise traffic movements in the local residential streets and have been formulated in conjunction with Victoria Police, local authorities and specialist traffic management consultants as part of an overall traffic management plan.

We have included a Residents Pass on the reverse side of this letter to assist with access to your street should you encounter a traffic controller on the day. To assist in the implementation of the plan it is advised that residents of Hudson St, Payne St, Eskdale Rd, Newington Gve and Redan Rd avoid using Glen Eira Road to return to their homes during the weekend of the 10th to 12th March.

The traffic management plan will be in effect on weekend of the 10th to 12th March 2012.

In summary, please note the following changes to normal conditions:

- Through roads that intersect with Kambrook Road will be closed, using Water Filled Barriers and road closure signs. Residents of these streets will have unimpeded access from Bambra Road at all times.
- Streets that are not accessible except from Kambrook Road will remain open to enable resident access at all times.
- Normanby Road will be closed to all traffic between Smith St and Queens Avenue from 8.00am on both Saturdays.
- Station Street, Smith Street and Normanby Road will remain open to normal traffic movements but will be closed for short durations should traffic conditions become congested and will be opened immediately the congestion clears.
- No entry is permitted into, Wyuna Road, Bond Street from Balaclava Road or Heywood Street from Normanby Road during the event except for residents. Signs will be in place to advise motorists of this requirement.
- Entry to Payne Street is only via Kambrook Road and some delays may be experienced due to the increased traffic volumes on Glen Eira Road.

Traffic in Bond St & Heywood St will be one way only and exit will be to Normanby Road or Balaclava Road at any time.

- The following streets will be closed to all traffic from Kambrook Road:
 - Eskdale Road, Newington Grove and Hudson Street at Kambrook Road; and
 - Entry for residents will be via Bambra Road Only

The closures in place are to be implemented in response to resident feedback and in an effort to reduce traffic using these streets (and improve residential amenity). Glen Eira Council has contacted residents in recent weeks and requested that the road closures in place for the Spring Carnival be implemented for the Caravan and Camping Show.
